LANG TEAM RACES 2026 REGULATIONS

ORLEN LANG TEAM RACE, ORLEN TOUR DE POLOGNE AMATEUR RACE – RYSZARD SZURKOWSKI MEMORIAL AND THE FAMILY RACE AND PARADE IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF CZESŁAW LANG

1. AIMS OF THE COMPETITION

- 1.1. To promote a healthy lifestyle, active leisure and recreation.
- 1.2. To popularise cycling and cycle tourism.
- 1.3. To promote localities and tourist trails.
- 1.4. To enable competition by combining sporting rivalry with recreation in the spirit of fair play.

2. NAMES OF THE COMPETITIONS

The races: ORLEN Lang Team Race, ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race – Ryszard Szurkowski Memorial and the Family Race in the Footsteps of Czesław Lang – hereinafter referred to as the "Race", and the Family Parade in the Footsteps of Czesław Lang – hereinafter referred to as the "Parade".

- 4.1. ORLEN Lang Team Race 16.05.2026 (Saturday) ARŁAMÓW Maxi distance 75 km
- 4.2. ORLEN Lang Team Race/ ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race Ryszard Szurkowski Memorial 08.08.2026 (Saturday) BUKOVINA Resort

Maxi distance 45-65 km

4.3. ORLEN Lang Team Race 19.09.2026 (Saturday) – BYTÓW

Mini distance 25-70 km Maxi distance 71-110 km

4.4. Family Race and Parade in the Footsteps of Czesław Lang 19.09.2026 (Saturday) – BYTÓW children's distance 5-10 km family parade 3-10 km

5. REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEES

- 5.1. Registering for the Races or the Parade is simultaneously a declaration that the Participant has read and accepted the terms of these Regulations.
- 5.2. Registration and payment of entry fees can be made both online and in person at the Race Office. The registration schedule, Office opening hours and entry fee amounts depend on the edition of the Race and will be published on the Organiser's website.
- 5.3. Registration schedule and entry fee amounts:

Registrations after 01.04.2026 do not guarantee receipt of a complete starter pack.

A 50% discount is available for participants under 18 years of age.

<u>08.08.2026 BUKOVINA RESORT</u> – ORLEN TOUR DE POLOGNE AMATEUR RACE, RYSZARD SZURKOWSKI MEMORIAL

PLN 195 – online registration and payment up to and including Tuesday 04.08.2026

PLN 250 – registration and payment by cash or card at the Race Office (in accordance with the programme published on the website)

Registrations after 01.07.2026 do not guarantee receipt of a complete starter pack.

PLN 450 VIP package – online registration and payment until 31.05.2026. Due to the limited number of places (250), VIP packages are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis according to payment order.

19.09.2026 BYTÓW – ORLEN LANG TEAM RACE, FAMILY RACE AND PARADE IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF CZESŁAW LANG

PLN 150 – online registration and payment up to and including Wednesday 16.09.2026

PLN 190 – registration and payment by cash or card at the Race Office (in accordance with the programme published on the website)

Registrations after 16.08.2026 do not guarantee receipt of a complete starter pack.

A 50% discount is available for participants under 18 years of age.

Participation in the Family Race and Parade in the Footsteps of Czesław Lang is free of charge.

It is possible to **pay for participation in three Races** (ORLEN Lang Team Race in Arlamów and Bytów, ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race at BUKOVINA Resort) at **PLN 465** for the basic package only via the online system up to and including 13.05.2026.

- 5.4. As part of the entry fee, the participant of the ORLEN Lang Team Race/ ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race receives a basic package: a race number with an electronic chip and refereeing services, professional timekeeping and results, a commemorative medal, sponsor gadgets, a recovery meal, a marked route, full medical security, support and assistance from the Organiser's services in situations requiring it, prizes for the winners (the full scope applies to basic packages paid for at earlier dates in accordance with section 5.3.) or a VIP package (the scope of the basic package plus additionally: a start from the first VIP sector at BUKOVINA Resort, a voucher for the personalisation of the commemorative medal, a T-shirt, a bag or a backpack).
- 5.5. The Race Office opening hours will be published on the Organiser's website.
- 5.6. When collecting the race number at the Race Office, the competitor may be asked to present proof of payment of the entry fee, an identity card or other relevant identification. Collection of race numbers by third parties is not permitted.
- 5.7. The Organiser does not refund the entry fee to persons who did not finish or did not start the competition. The fee cannot be transferred to third parties. Fees are non-refundable, except in the event of a necessary reduction in the number of competitors or cancellation of the Race by the Organiser.
- 5.8. The Organiser reserves the right to change the limit of participants and to close registration and entry fee payments early if the limit of places is reached (the order of payment is decisive).

The ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race has a limit of 2,500 competitors.

The Family Race in the Footsteps of Czesław Lang has a limit of 200 competitors.

6. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

- 6.1. Only a person (hereinafter the Participant) who meets the conditions specified in this section 6, and in particular, may participate in the Race/Parade:
- 6.1.1. Registers by filling in the registration form and pays the entry fee (the fee applies to the ORLEN Lang Team Race and the ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race, the fee does not apply to the Family Race

and Parade in the Footsteps of Czesław Lang).

- 6.1.2. Is of legal age, or was born between 2008-2010 and has written consent to participate from a parent/legal guardian and an adult providing direct supervision during the ORLEN Lang Team Race/ ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race.
- 6.1.3. Was born between 2011-2016 and has written consent to participate from a parent/legal guardian and an adult providing direct supervision during the Family Race in the Footsteps of Czesław Lang.
- 6.1.4. Participation in the Family Parade in the Footsteps of Czesław Lang is open to children up to and including 15 years of age (year of birth up to 2011) who have written consent to participate from a parent/legal guardian and an adult providing direct supervision during the Parade. A child is obliged to participate in the Family Parade in the Footsteps of Czesław Lang with a guardian.
- 6.1.5. Participates at their own risk (and in the case of underage Participants, at the risk of a parent or legal guardian) and should have third-party liability and personal accident insurance for their own benefit. The Organiser does not provide insurance for Participants.
- 6.1.6. Is in very good health and has no medical contraindications to participate in the cycling event, which they automatically confirm by completing the registration form. In the case of underage Participants, confirmation of good health and lack of contraindications is provided by the parent/legal guardian.
- 6.2. Every Participant is obliged to ride in a rigid helmet.
- 6.3. Only persons on technically sound bicycles equipped with functioning brakes may take part in the Race and Parade.

The use of full-disc wheels and deep-rim wheels, any kind of handlebar extensions (used on time trial bikes, i.e. aerobars) and axle extensions (known from stunt bikes), and participation on electric or mechanically assisted bicycles is forbidden.

- 6.4. In case of non-compliance with the equipment conditions, the referees will apply one of the penalties listed in section 12 of the Regulations to the Participant.
- 6.5. Participants are prohibited from using headphones while riding.
- 6.6. Every Participant is obliged to familiarise themselves with the race route.
- 6.7. Accompanying vehicles on the Race route are strictly forbidden.
- 6.8. The Organiser reserves the right to authorise medical and paramedical personnel employed by or on behalf of the Organiser to provide first aid or perform other medical procedures, as well as to transport an injured competitor to a safe place. The competitor consents to the above actions.
- 6.9. The sporting events organised by Lang Team and covered by these Regulations are open to all amateur road cyclists, with the exclusion of competitors holding Elite and U23 cycling licenses.

7. RACE NUMBERS AND TIMEKEEPING

- 7.1. Electronic timekeeping and Participant identification will be used during the Races.
- 7.2. Upon confirming their registration at the Race Office, each participant will receive a non-returnable, individual race number with an electronic chip. The rigid race number must be mounted on the seat post under the saddle, and the second number pinned to the back. The Participant is forbidden from making any alterations to the appearance of the received number. Using only one race number is forbidden under penalty of disqualification.
- 7.3. In the event of loss or destruction of a race number by the Participant, the Organiser will provide a new set upon payment of a fee of PLN 20.
- 7.4. Participants who lose their race number during the Race or whose chip malfunctions (no audible signal at a checkpoint) must report this fact to the referees' commission or the computer staff at the finish line.

- 7.5. Sectoral starts are in effect at the competition competitors starting from the same sector have the same start time (the first timing mat is at the start line; failure to cross it will result in automatic disqualification).
- 7.6. There is a time limit for reaching the finish line, as indicated in the programme of each Race.
- 7.7. Timekeeping is not used during the Parade.

8. RULES FOR CONDUCTING THE CYCLING EVENT

- 8.1. The Races and Parade will take place on a designated, marked route, with partially restricted road traffic. Route maps for each of the Races will be available on the Organiser's website.
- 8.2. The Race routes are marked and secured by the appropriate services, medical rescuers, technical support and marshals.
- 8.3. During the ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race at BUKOVINA Resort, the start in all age categories will be a mass start according to the following rules:
- 8.3.1. Competitors may line up in any starting sector except for: the first VIP sector (reserved for competitors with a VIP package) and the second Lang Team sector, reserved for the Organiser's needs.
- 8.3.2. Participants of the Polish Police Mountain Road Cycling Championships for the Cup of the Chief Police Commander and the 12th Polish Championships of PSP Firefighters in Road Cycling must use the sector designated by the Organiser before the start.
- 8.3.3. The people with the best times from the ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race 2025 (the top three women and the top three men) are entitled to start from the VIP sector.
- 8.4. During the Races in Arłamów and Bytów, the starts will be sectoral mass starts, divided by category. The line-up for each edition will be communicated before the start.
- 8.5. Sectoral starts are planned at 1-2 minute intervals according to the Referees' decision.
- 8.6. Changing the starting sector will be penalised with a 30-minute time penalty.
- 8.7. There are unmarked checkpoints located on the route. Skipping a checkpoint will be disqualified.
- 8.8. A competitor who does not reach the finish line within the time limit will not be classified.
- 8.9. In special cases, bearing in mind the well-being of the competitors, the Chief Referee, in consultation with the Race medical team, has the right to withdraw a Participant from the competition.
- 8.10. After the Race, competitors may be randomly called for an anti-doping control. A board with the race numbers of the competitors selected for the control will be placed in a visible location at the finish line. Failure to report for the anti-doping control within 30 minutes of the numbers being announced will result in the competitor's disqualification.

9. AGE CATEGORIES

9.1. The following age categories apply during the ORLEN Lang Team Race / ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race:

Women:

- K20 16-29 YEARS2010 1997
- K30 30-39 YEARS1996 1987
- K40 40-49 YEARS1986 1977
- K50 50 + YEARS 1976 and older

Men:

- M10 16-19 YEARS2010 2007
- M20 20-29 YEARS2006 1997
- M30 30-39 YEARS1996 1987
- M40 40-44 YEARS1986 1982

- M45 45-49 YEARS1981 1977
- M50 50-54 YEARS1976 1972
- M55 55-59 YEARS1971 1967
- M60 60-64 YEARS1966 1962
- M65 65-69 YEARS1961 1957
- M70 70-74 YEARS1956 1952
- M75 75 + YEARS 1951 and older
- 9.2. The OPEN category applies to all Participants in the Family Race in the Footsteps of Czesław Lang.

10. CLASSIFICATIONS

- 10.1. During each of the ORLEN Lang Team Race / ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race, the following classifications will be held: individual and team.
- 10.2. The **individual classification of each Race** will be conducted according to categories, divided by age and gender.
- 10.3. The winner of the ORLEN Lang Team Race in Arlamów and Bytów, the ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race at BUKOVINA Resort and the Family Race in the Footsteps of Czesław Lang will be the competitor who covers the route in the shortest time and does not miss any checkpoints.
- 10.4. **As part of the ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race** at BUKOVINA Resort, additional individual classifications will apply:
- 10.4.1. **OPEN women's and OPEN men's classification** (best time regardless of age category).
- 10.4.2. Polish Police Mountain Road Cycling Championships for the Cup of the Chief Police Commander (serving and retired Police officers and employees may take part in the Championships). To enter this classification, you must register during online registration and present your service, employee or retiree/pensioner ID card for inspection at the Race Office. This classification will be conducted in the categories:
- WOMEN OPEN
- MEN M1, up to 44 years (born 1982 and younger),
- MEN M2, from 45 years (born 1981 and older).
- 10.4.3. **12**th **Polish Championships of PSP Firefighters in Road Cycling** (serving and retired PSP officers and employees may take part). To enter this classification, you must register during online registration and send an application to the National Headquarters of the State Fire Service. At the Race Office, you must present your service, employee or retiree/pensioner ID card for inspection. The classification for PSP officers will be conducted in the categories:
- WOMEN OPEN
- MEN OPEN
- MEN M1, up to 29 years (born 1997 and younger),
- MEN M2, 30-39 years (born 1996-1987),
- MEN M3, 40-49 years (born 1986-1977),
- MEN M4, from 50 years (born 1976 and older).
- 10.5. Cyclists with a Masters licence, participating in the ORLEN Lang Team Race in Arlamów and Bytów and the ORLEN Tour de Pologne Amateur Race at BUKOVINA Resort, gain points for the Masters Commission classification in accordance with the Masters Commission scoring rules.
- 10.6. In the Family Race in the Footsteps of Czesław Lang, only an individual classification in the OPEN Women and OPEN Men categories will be conducted.

- 10.7. The announcement of the top three competitors in each category will take place during the official podium ceremony. The classification results will be published on the Organiser's website.
- 10.8. The Family Parade in the Footsteps of Czesław Lang is held without sporting competition, therefore no classification will be conducted.
- 10.9. The **individual general classification** is an OPEN classification divided into women and men, regardless of age categories. The classification is based on the sum of the times of a competitor participating in all editions: in Arłamów, BUKOVINA Resort and Bytów on the Maxi distance. The awards ceremony for the winners of the individual, general OPEN classification (the top three women and the top three men) will take place at the last edition of the event in Bytów, on 16.09.2026.
- 10.10. Within the Races in Arłamów, BUKOVINA Resort and Bytów on the Maxi distance, a **team classification** will be conducted. During registration, you must enter the exact same team name. The team must be a mixed team and consist of a minimum of 4 Participants (e.g. 3 male competitors and 1 female competitor).
- 10.11. The team classification results are based on the sum of the times of the three best male competitors and the one best female competitor. The winning team will be decorated on the podium.
- 10.12. The **team general classification** is a classification for which the sum of the times of the four best Participants (the mixed team rule applies) from the individual editions in Arlamów, BUKOVINA Resort and Bytów on the Maxi distance will be calculated. The awards ceremony for the winners will take place at the last edition of the event in Bytów, on 16.09.2026.

11. RULES OF MOVEMENT ON THE ROUTE AND ROAD TRAFFIC

- 11.1. The Races and Parade will take place with partially restricted road traffic, therefore Participants must obey traffic regulations. In particularly dangerous places, the Police and the Organiser's services will facilitate merging with traffic.
- 11.2. All competitors should move along the route in the right-hand lane of the road or its right-hand side, in accordance with traffic regulations. Competitors should exercise particular caution when the route is technically difficult or when they are approaching an intersection.
- 11.3. Competitors must be particularly cautious, bearing in mind the possibility of vehicles emerging from fields, roads or buildings and from minor roads.
- 11.4. The Organiser is not liable for any collisions and accidents on the route.
- 11.5. In the case of a time loss of more than 15 minutes to the pilot leading a given age group, the Police have the right to stop participants at intersections to allow road traffic to pass.
- 11.6. Competitors must strictly follow the instructions of the security services and the Police.
- 11.7. During the event, a slower-moving competitor should give way to a competitor achieving a higher speed, by moving to the right-hand side of the route.
- 11.8. Each competitor, when tackling downhill sections of the route, should adapt their speed to their abilities and also apply the principle of limited trust towards other competitors. It is necessary to exercise particular caution in the dangerous places indicated by the Organiser.
- 11.9. During the finishing sprint, a competitor must hold their line. Blocking other competitors will be disqualified.

12. PENALTIES

The referees' commission, in agreement with the Organiser, may apply the following penalties: refusal to allow participation, warning, time penalty or disqualification.

13. PROTESTS

Protests may be submitted in writing to the Chief Referee for 30 minutes after the announcement of the

results. The Chief Referee's decision is final and not subject to further verification.

14. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

Competitors should respect the natural environment and only move along the officially designated route. Competitors may not contaminate the area or leave litter on the route. The use of glass containers is forbidden. In case of violation of this rule, competitors will be disqualified.

15. PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA AND COMPETITORS' PERSONAL RIGHTS

15.1. The competitor and parents or legal guardians give their voluntary consent to the processing of their personal data and the child's data and the use of the competitors' image for the purposes of publicly announcing the results of the event and for the promotion and marketing of the cycling event, as well as consent to the following clauses:

"I consent, within the meaning of Art. 81(1) of the Act on Copyright and Related Rights, to the free-of-charge recording and use of the competitor's image and their statements recorded for the purposes of or in connection with the cycling event by the Organiser and the event's Sponsors (including ORLEN Spółka Akcyjna with its registered office in Płock (postcode: 09-411) ul. Chemików 7), without limitation of time, territory and quantity, by producing copies using any technique on which the image was recorded, placing on the market, lending or hiring the original or copies, public performance, exhibition, display, reproduction and broadcasting and re-emitting, making publicly available on the Internet and Intranet and all communication channels of the Organiser/Sponsors, using in all forms of advertising, communication, promotion and marketing of the cycling event (and its future editions), as well as of the Organiser and Sponsors, including through all mass media (e.g. television, press, radio, on billboards, posters, leaflets), making and authorising third parties to make derivative works (including alterations and adaptations) and to transfer these rights to third parties, provided that the form of presentation is not offensive."

"I consent to the processing of my personal data (the data of my child who is a competitor) collected, among others, in the registration form and in materials recorded during the cycling event by the Organiser for the purposes of ensuring the competitor's participation in the event, as well as for archival, informational and evidentiary purposes."

The consents referred to in this provision may be withdrawn at any time, but their withdrawal makes it impossible to take part in the cycling event.

- 15.2. The competitor's data and image may be used in particular in informational materials issued by the Organiser and/or its Sponsors related to the competition, its organisation and promotion, and in materials promoting events accompanying the cycling event (press, radio, television, internet, graphic materials) also in future years.
- 15.3. Giving consent to the use of the competitor's image is equivalent to the irrevocable transfer to the Organiser and Sponsors of the economic copyrights to the video and/or photo coverage and their use in the following fields of exploitation:
- 15.3.1. reproducing the photographic work by printing and other similar techniques,
- 15.3.2. placing on the market the copies of the reproduction referred to in section 15.3.1,
- 15.3.3. public exhibition, display and reproduction of the photographic Work,
- 15.3.4. making a digital record of the photographic Work and introducing it to the Internet as a form of dissemination,
- 15.3.5. introducing the photographic Work into one's own electronic database, in its original form, in whole or in part, and making it available on the Internet.
- The Participants and their aforementioned legal representatives are not entitled to any further remuneration, in particular remuneration for the use of the image and personal data of individual competitors, other than the prizes.

- 15.4. The principles of processing the personal data of competitors, parents and guardians are included in the information clause, and to obtain additional information, please contact the data controller or the data protection officer.
- 15.5. The competitor shall be liable to the Organiser for damages in the event of any claims being made against persons entitled to use their personal rights in accordance with this section 15.
- 15.6. Competitors must meet all the requirements of the regulations to be able to participate in the cycling event.
- 15.7. The controller of the personal data collected in the registration forms and collected during and in connection with the cycling event is Lang Team Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Warsaw (02-792), ul. Pachnąca 81. The controller can be contacted by e-mail at sekretariat@langteam.com.pl, by telephone on +48 22 649 24 91 or in writing to the address of the controller's registered office.
- 15.8. The personal data controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted on matters concerning the processing of personal data and the exercise of rights related to data processing in the same way as the data controller specified above.
- 15.9. The data provided will be processed for purposes related to participation in the cycling event, as well as for archival, informational, evidentiary purposes and for the marketing and promotion of own products and services. The processing of data is necessary for the realisation of the event and the legitimate interest of the controller, i.e. direct marketing of own services and products the legal basis for processing data for the purpose of realising the cycling event is Art. 6(1)(b) and for other purposes Art. 6(1)(f) of the GDPR.
- 15.10. The data provided may be transferred to entities processing personal data on behalf of the controller, including providers of timekeeping services, IT, marketing agencies, event sponsors whereby such entities will process data on the basis of a contract with the controller, exclusively within the scope and for the purpose indicated in sections 15.1, 15.2, 15.3. The personal data of competitors will not be transferred to recipients located in countries outside the European Economic Area.
- 15.11. The personal data provided will be stored for the time necessary for the implementation of the event and the participant's rights arising from participation in the event, but not longer than 5 years from the time of their acquisition. The controller will cease to process data used for direct marketing purposes earlier if the competitor objects to the processing of their data for these purposes.
- 15.12. The competitor has the right to access their data and the right to request their rectification, erasure or restriction of their processing. The competitor has the right to object to the processing of data for direct marketing purposes.
- 15.13. To the extent that the basis for the processing of the competitor's personal data is consent, the competitor has the right to withdraw that consent. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
- 15.14. To the extent that the competitor's data is processed on the basis of consent the competitor has the right to data portability, i.e. to receive their personal data from the controller in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format. The competitor may send this data to another data controller.
- 15.15. The competitor also has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority for personal data protection.
- 15.16. To exercise the above rights, please contact the data controller or the data protection officer. Contact details are given above.
- 15.17. The provision of personal data in connection with participation in the cycling event is necessary. The provision of personal data for marketing purposes is voluntary.

16. FINAL PROVISIONS

16.1. The Organiser is not liable for accidents and random events that occur during the Participants'

travel to and from the competition.

- 16.2. Each Participant takes part in the competition at their own risk (in the case of underage competitors, at the risk of their parents or legal guardians).
- 16.3. The only and binding template for the declaration for the participation of minors is published on the Organiser's website and constitutes an appendix to these Regulations. The declaration must be downloaded from the website, printed, signed and submitted when collecting the race numbers at the Race Office. The parent or legal guardian is obliged to show their identity card when registering the competitor.
- 16.4. The Organiser and all persons acting on its behalf or with its authorisation in connection with the conduct and organisation of the competition shall not be liable for personal, material and property damage to competitors that occurs before, during or after the competition.
- 16.5. Participants bear civil liability for all damages caused by them through their own, sole fault to other participants of the cycling event and to third parties.
- 16.6. The Organiser is not liable for any collisions and accidents on the route caused by the fault of a participant.
- 16.7. In the event of an accident or damage related to the event, Participants may not pursue claims for damages against the Organiser or persons acting on its behalf or with its authorisation, in connection with the conduct and organisation of the competition.
- 16.8. Participants declare that all personal data and health data completed by them in the registration form are complete and true.
- 16.9. Participants undertake to comply with the orders and instructions of the Organiser's marshals during the competition. They may not use vulgar words or behave in an unsportsmanlike manner.
- 16.10. Participants undertake to comply with the terms of the Regulations and the conditions of participation. Registration confirms that you have read and accepted the Regulations for participation in the competition.
- 16.11. Competitors suspended from their rights as a competitor by the Disciplinary Commission of the Polish Cycling Federation (PZKoI) do not have the right to participate in cycling events organised by Lang Team until this suspension expires.
- 16.12. There may be steep climbs and dangerous descents on the route.
- 16.13. The Races and Parade will take place regardless of weather conditions. In the event of force majeure and/or extreme weather conditions that threaten the safety of the Participants, the Organiser, in consultation with the Chief Referee, may cancel or interrupt the cycling event.
- 16.14. Ignorance of the Regulations and non-compliance with them will not be considered by the Organiser as an excuse for actions inconsistent with its provisions.
- 16.15. The Organiser, with the Chief Referee, reserves the right to interpret these Regulations and to amend them.
- 16.16. Doping control will be carried out in accordance with Polish law and anti-doping regulations.
